<b>Non-Traditional Scholarship</b>	Recent GED graduate with an Honors Score of 170 or above on at least two of the four sections of the GED test	<b>Tuition</b> (up to 15 credit hours per semester) May be awarded up to four consecutive semesters	August 5 <sup>th</sup>
<b>Foundation Scholarship</b>	Financial need (Federal Aid application on file) <b>Essay explaining your educational goals &amp; economic needs</b>	<b>\$500</b> per semester	Fall: May 2 <sup>nd</sup> Spring: November 25 <sup>th</sup>
